ADDITIONAL NOTES FOR VENDORS

- Vendors must be fully set up no later than **30 minutes prior to the event start time of 6:00 PM**. Tear-down may begin **after the start of the second act**, following the completion of the intermission.
- You will be assigned a **designated vending location** by the event organizer. Locations are non-transferable without prior approval.
- **Waste management is the vendor's responsibility.** Please remove all garbage, recycling, and grey water from your assigned area at the end of each evening.
- **Products containing alcohol or cannabis are not permitted for sale at the event.**
- **Limited power access** is available and must be arranged in advance with the event organizers. Vendors must supply their own extension cords and power-safe equipment as required. Generators are permitted but will not be provided by the event organizers. The venue (City of Williams Lake Boitanio Park) has 15 amp power outlets available for use.
- The vendor is solely responsible for ensuring **full compliance with all applicable health, safety, fire, and municipal codes and regulations**, including WorkSafeBC requirements and any additional public health guidelines in effect during the event.
- By participating in the event, vendors consent to the use of photos or video of their booth and team for promotional and archival purposes.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS & WAIVER

By signing below, the vendor agrees to the following:

The event organizers and the City of Williams Lake, or the Cariboo Regional District are not responsible for any loss, damage, theft, or injury occurring during or in connection with the event.

The vendor assumes all risks and responsibilities related to their participation, including setup, operation, and takedown of their booth or food truck. The vendor agrees to provide proof of comprehensive general liability insurance for their operations. The vendor assumes all responsibility for any damage to their equipment, products, or personnel. The event organizer is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage incurred before, during, or after the event.

The vendor agrees that participation in Performances in the Park event cannot proceed without producing the required documentation to event organizers.

The vendor agrees to comply with all applicable health and safety regulations as set out by Interior Health, the City of Williams Lake, and any provincial or federal authorities.

The vendor waives any right to claim against the event organizers, sponsors, volunteers, or the City of Williams Lake and the Cariboo Regional District for any property damage, personal injury, or loss incurred as part of the event.
